

# All datasheet Columns

The contents of this page will be a bit technical, you don't need to read it for a simple utilisation of this tool. First use the [Main datasheet columns](#) and pick the features you're interested in from the [Excel features](#), only then, if needed, come back to this page.

Here we will present all the Columns available in this tool.

Here are some of the important characteristics of these columns:

- **Mandatory:** the data in the cell is needed to target the component in the row and create it, without it, the row is ignored.
- **Unique:** there can be only one column with this name, if there are more than one, only the first one will be taken into account.
- **Multiple:** the column can have several SubColumns.
- **Dynamic:** contrary to all the other columns, here the name of the column doesn't matter, what the column does will be determined by its subColumn.
- **SubComponent:** this column will target one of the line component's subComponent (an Alarm, History etc).
